Distribution

Out of each gift made to the Lincoln Fellow program 80% is invested within the permanent restricted Endowment Fund. The remaining 20% is placed in the General Fund of the SUCVW Charitable Foundation for current grants.

Each year no more than 80% of the interest from the Endowment Fund will be transferred to the General Fund to fund grants by the SUCVW Charitable Foundation. The remaining funds are reinvested in the Endowment Fund to assist in the growth of the endowment fund.

Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War Charitable Foundation



The Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War Charitable Foundation was created in Sandusky, Ohio on March 8, 2003 exclusively for educational and charitable purposes.

Those purposes broadly include:

Providing information on and enlightenment of the Armed Conflict of 1861-1865.

Supporting projects and charities attributable to Civil War history; monument preservation, restoration, construction, and erection; scholarships; and benevolence to members of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War.

The SUVCW Charitable Foundation was incorporated in the State of Ohio and maintains headquarters at the Ohio Veterans Home/Museum in Sandusky, Ohio. The Foundation is tax exempt under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

Concept

The Abraham Lincoln Endowment Fund was established by the SUVCW Charitable Foundation on March 8, 2007, which is also the fourth anniversary of the founding of the SUVCW Charitable Foundation.

After reviewing the first four years of fund raising to meet the purposes of the SUVCW Charitable Foundation, it has become apparent that additional steps need to be taken to realize the full mission.

The Abraham Lincoln Endowment Fund was founded with two chief goals in mind:

(1) Establish a permanent restricted fund, the income of which will help provide adequate financial resources for projects selected for funding by the SUVCW Charitable Foundation.

(2) Provide an immediate source of funds to be used in the short term to provide financial contributions that fulfill the mission of the SUVCW Charitable Foundation.

Until the inception of the Endowment Fund, The SUVCW Charitable Foundation was dependant upon donations made by individuals and/or groups, with a minimal amount of funds being retained to insure future growth.

General

The purpose of the Abraham Lincoln Endowment Fund is to maintain a continuing program for obtaining and distributing funds to support the mission of the SUVCW Charitable Foundation.

The SUVCW Charitable Foundation conducts fundraising activities at camp, department, and national levels.

All gifts are important and are tax deductible under the SUVCW Charitable Foundation's tax exempt status as a 501 (c) (3) organization.

Individuals or groups donating at one of the three levels of \$1000, \$500, or \$250 are recognized as Abraham Lincoln Fellows. The gifts must include an initial down payment of 25% and the balance may be paid monthly, quarterly or semi-annually over a two year period. Corporate matching funds will count in an individual's total contribution for purposes of determining the Lincoln Fellow level.

Each person recognized as a Lincoln Fellow at the Gold, Silver, or Bronze level will receive a distinctive medal and a certificate. A Lincoln Fellow can move to the next level by contributing the necessary additional funds.
